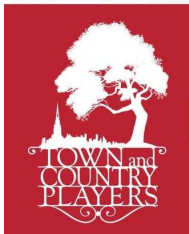
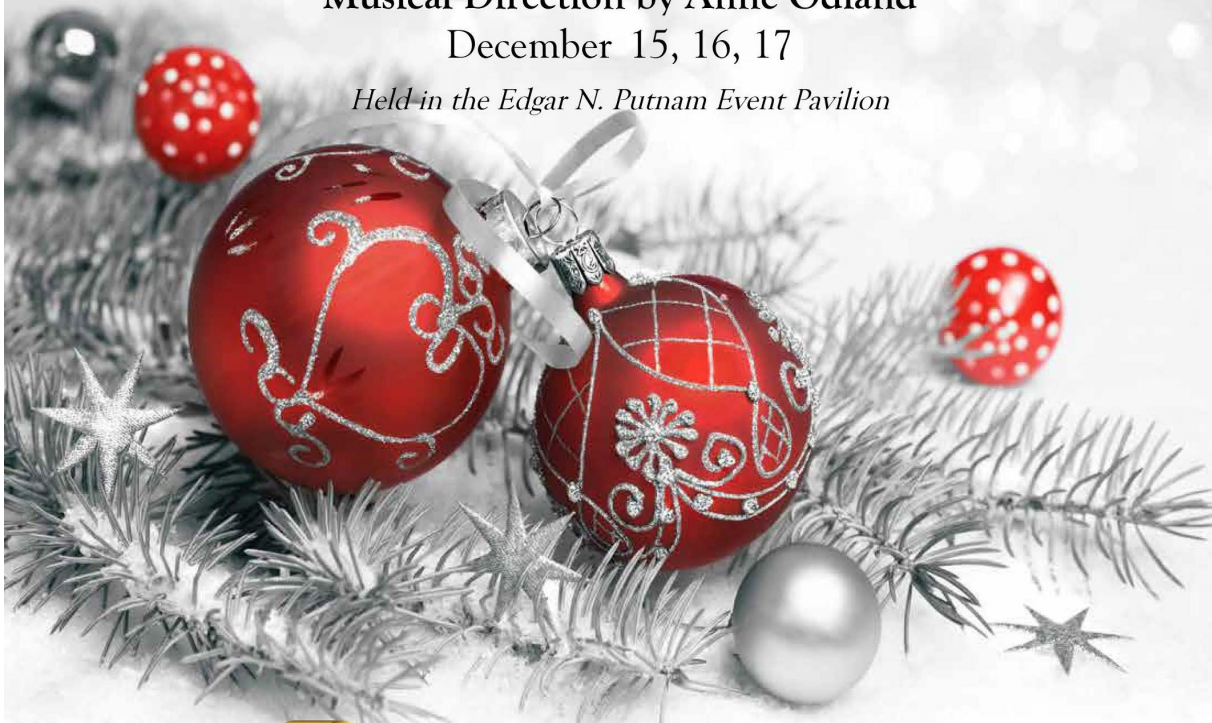

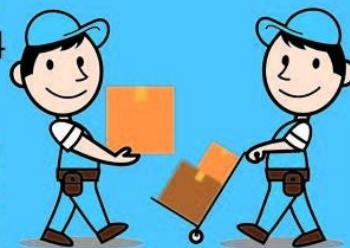

A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

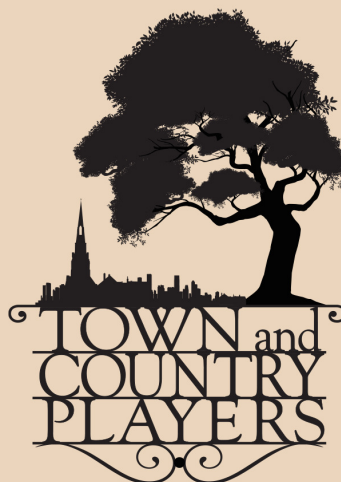
It is hard to believe that we now stand poised to celebrate the final production of our 70th anniversary season.
