DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Murder mysteries, from Edgar Allan Poe and Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, through Dorothy Sayers, Dashiell Hammett, Hitchcock, King and beyond, have brought shivers of dread and made voyages into the murky swamps of dark souls for nearly 200 years. "The Murders in the Rue Morgue" was first published in 1841 and was followed in 1843 by "The Tell-Tale Heart". Poe's grasp of the perversities of the criminal mind and the strangeness of human nature would be the awakening of a literary age and the birth of an audience eager to witness the carnage, if from a safe distance.

Dr. Jekyll becoming Mr. Hyde: How shocking but I'll watch!
Professor Moriarty, mastermind vs mastermind: Sounds like a fair fight. Flocks of ordinary birds: Who would have thought?
Hannibal Lecter: Just spare me the gory details. Though, it's not only the villains who mesmerize the public's gaze, the continuing sagas of Sherlock Holmes, Sam Spade, Raymond Chandler, Miss Marple, Hercule Poirot, Perry Mason and more have gathered their own adoring fans in their time. How delightful to visualize these characters. To exchange places with Sam Spade and track down the Maltese Falcon! To become a sleuth and win the day.

Agatha Christie was a master of the genre. Taunting with intricate detail, shocking by sudden turns and wholly laying bare the flaws and failures of the spirit. Her works include 66 detective novels, 14 short story collections and 6 novels written under a pseudonym (Mary Westmacott). The Mousetrap remains the world's longest continuous running play (albeit with a brief respite during covid), beginning in 1952. Tonight's production is performed as originally written but adapted to fit our unusual playing space. All else is to the best of our abilities as she intended.

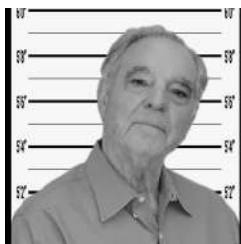


Valerie Sharper

T&C WANTS YOU TO KNOW.....

Welcome to the Town and Country Players' 2023 Season. This season is our 76th season of bringing quality community theater to the Bucks County Area.

Last year, we celebrated our 75th Anniversary Season with a full schedule, including five mainstage productions, a One Act Festival, a 24-Hour Play Festival, a Ballet, and a Holiday Show. This year, we once again have a full calendar of events, with five mainstage shows, the return of our One Act Festival and Holiday Show, and a new-to-T&C Youth Musical this summer. In addition, we are continuing to offer our Youth Workshops this summer, and other workshops on all aspects of theater throughout the year.

But none of our productions would be possible without the having a location to perform in. This winter, we accomplished major upgrades in our space to both improve the patron experience and the quality of the product presented on stage.

The major upgrade this winter was a \$20,000 improvement to our front parking lot. As you may be aware, due to environmental concerns and the need to control storm water runoff, our parking areas are not paved, but grass covered. In general, this works well, but in times of heavy rain, can cause issues.

To address this, we installed environmentally friendly permeable pavers to stabilize the handicapped and front parking areas and improve the experience for our patrons. We were also able to significantly upgrade our electrical system in support of our stage lighting needs.

Of course, we never want to stop improving our unique facility. Our next planned capital improvement project is the installation of an ADA compliant handicap ramp to allow easier access to our facility for all. To get this ramp built, we will continue to rely upon the support of our patrons and donors to enable us to provide high quality community theater to all the residents of the Central Bucks area for many years to come.

In closing, I would like to thank all of our patrons, season ticket holders, Gold Patrons, and donors over the years. Your generosity has enabled us to keep the lights on, improve our infrastructure, and weather hard times.

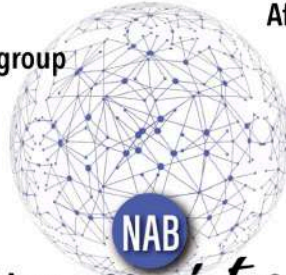

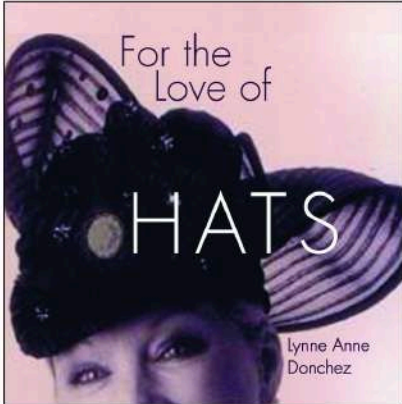

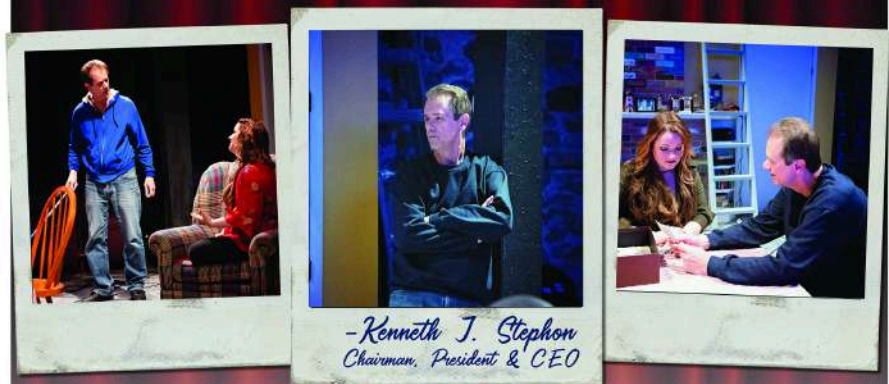
