# DIRECTOR'S NOTES

---

## **Kallie Cooper-Damon**, *The Lifeboat is Sinking*

Did you know Shel Silverstein was more than just a children's book author? I did not! With a little digging I discovered Silverstein was a cartoonist, songwriter, illustrator, poet, and playwright. *The Lifeboat is Sinking* is part of a compilation of short plays presented as *An Adult Evening of Shel Silverstein*. Each play is not what you would expect, if you only know Silverstein as the author of *The Giving Tree*. They are funny, eccentric, and even a little raunchy. *The Lifeboat is Sinking* made me laugh and made me think. I hope it makes you do the same.

## **Joe O'Neill**, *Your Mother's Butt*

You may have already had a chuckle or two from the works of screenwriter Alan Ball. He is a writer and director who has made a significant impact on American culture. He is best known for his work on the hit TV shows *Six Feet Under* and *True Blood*, as well as the Academy Award-winning film *American Beauty*. His work often explores complex themes such as identity, sexuality, and the meaning of life.

I am proud to bring *Your Mother's Butt* to the stage. This play is a unique exploration of the relationship between a young adult and his psychologist, as well as a reflection on society's obsession with appearance. As the play unfolds, we see how his obsession with fashion goes beyond just clothing, and becomes a lens through which he views the world. *Your Mother's Butt* is a play that will leave you laughing, thinking, and talking long after the lights go down.

## **Jackie Parzanese**, *Post-Its - Notes on a Marriage*

*Post-Its: Notes on a Marriage* allows a look into the deepest and truest intimacies of a partnership, from initial attraction, through some of life's many ups and downs, and finally, to the natural and eventual conclusion of any relationship. Through a unique storytelling method, we get to watch a couple's whole lives unfold (literally), which was one of the things that most drew me to this script.

Traditionally performed as a table read, we've decided to switch it up, add some movement, and have some fun! Here we witness a fascinating interplay of intimacy versus distance as the audience becomes privy to this couple's closest moments, which we see communicated in the most casual method one could use to relay a message: the Post-It Note.

I'm confident that you'll find something to connect to in this touching story that conveys some of life's most heartfelt moments. I have absolutely loved helping to bring these characters to life and watching them grow old together, and I hope you do, too!  
P.S. You (probably) need milk.

## **Michael Schiumo**, *Variations on the Death of Trotsky*

What if you could do over a moment in your life so that the ending was perfect? While you're at it, try other variations, and see how they all play out? Funny, tragic, confusing, there's always a perspective for life's moments. I first performed this play in college and loved the humor in it. Fast forward 20 plus years, and there are so many more layers to it, and more angles to explore. I hope you enjoy these variations of one of life's biggest moments...its end, and see if you can find the humor, the tears, and even the acceptance in its inevitable conclusion.

## **Nicole Zucal**, *The Role of Della*

Welcome to *The Role of Della*, a comedy where an eager young actress has her eyes set on the role of Della. Can she convince a cold, sarcastic director that she's right for the part? This riveting and riotous look at the contemporary audition process, gives new meaning to the term "stealing a scene". ## T&C WANTS YOU TO KNOW.....

Welcome to the Town and Country Players' 2023 Season. This season is our 76<sup>th</sup> season of bringing quality community theater to the Bucks County Area. Last year, we celebrated our 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Season with a full schedule, including five mainstage productions, a One Act Festival, a 24-Hour Play Festival, a Ballet, and a Holiday Show.

This year, we once again have a full calendar of events, with five mainstage shows, the return of our One Act Festival and Holiday Show, another 24-Hour Play Festival, and a new-to-T&C Youth Musical this summer. In addition, we are continuing to offer our Youth Workshops this summer, and other workshops on all aspects of theater throughout the year.

But none of our productions would be possible without the having a location to perform in. This winter, we accomplished major upgrades in our space to both improve the patron experience and the quality of the product presented on stage.

The major upgrade this winter was a \$20,000 improvement to our front parking lot. As you may be aware, due to environmental concerns and the need to control storm water runoff, our parking areas are not paved, but grass covered. In general, this works well, but in times of heavy rain, can cause issues.

To address this, we installed environmentally friendly permeable pavers to stabilize the handicap and front parking areas and improve the experience for our patrons. We were also able to significantly upgrade our electrical system in support of our stage lighting needs.

Of course, we never want to stop improving our unique facility. Our next planned capital improvement project is the installation of an ADA compliant handicap ramp to allow easier access to our facility for all. To get this ramp built, we will continue to rely upon the support of our patrons and donors to enable us to provide high quality community theater to all the residents of the Central Bucks area for many years to come.

In closing, I would like to thank all of our patrons, season ticket holders, Gold Patrons, and donors over the years. Your generosity has enabled us to keep the lights on, improve our infrastructure, and weather hard times.
