DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Dr. Seuss books have been a favorite of mine since I was a child. Growing up, my favorite character was Sam from Green Eggs and Ham. As a parent I enjoyed reading Seuss books to my children and the whimsical rhyming carried into our own conversions. As an owner and director of a preschool, I love how Seuss characters imbody many of the best qualities in a person's character with a good measure of playfulness and optimism.

Dr. Seuss books and *Seussical the Musical* appealed to me because of the universal themes, such as creative thinking, tolerance, friendship, loyalty, unconditional love and believing that anything is possible, as well as the truly beautiful score by Stephen Flaherty and Lynn Ahrens (the team that penned *Ragtime* and *Once on this Island*).

As you will see and hear, our inspirational creative team and wildly talented cast brought a lot to the production table and are serving it up "Seuss-Style" with a special side of Green Eggs and Ham!

American author, Theodor Seuss Geisel (March 2, 1904–September 24, 1991) wrote and illustrated several of the most popular children's books of all time, which have helped generations of readers not only learn, but love, to read.

Dr. Seuss's honors include two Academy Awards, two Emmy Awards, a Peabody Award, and the Pulitzer Prize. Though he devoted most of his life to writing children's books, he had no children of his own, saying: "You have 'em; I'll entertain 'em."

Other theater includes In Your Arms (Old Globe), Little Dancer (Kennedy Center), Lucky Stiff (Playwrights Horizons) and Loving Repeating: A Musical of Gertrude Stein (Chicago's Jefferson Award. Best New Musical.) Film includes Anastasia (two Academy Award and two Golden Globe nominations), the documentary After the Storm and Lucky Stiff. Last year, we celebrated our 75th Anniversary Season with a full schedule, including five mainstage productions, a One Act Festival, a 24-Hour Play Festival, a Ballet, and a Holiday Show. This year, we once again have a full calendar of events, with five mainstage shows, the return of our One Act Festival and Holiday Show, another 24-Hour Play Festival, and a new-to-T&C Youth Musical this summer. In addition, we are continuing to offer our Youth Workshops this summer, and other workshops on all aspects of theater throughout the year.

But none of our productions would be possible without the having a location to perform in. This winter, we accomplished major upgrades in our space to both improve the patron experience and the quality of the product presented on stage.

The major upgrade this winter was a \$20,000 improvement to our front parking lot. As you may be aware, due to environmental concerns and the need to control storm water runoff, our parking areas are not paved, but grass covered. In general, this works well, but in times of heavy rain, can cause issues.

To address this, we installed environmentally friendly permeable pavers to stabilize the handicapped and front parking areas and improve the experience for our patrons. We were also able to significantly upgrade our electrical system in support of our stage lighting needs.

Of course, we never want to stop improving our unique facility. Our next planned capital improvement project is the installation of an ADA compliant handicap ramp to allow easier access to our facility for all. To get this ramp built, we will continue to rely upon the support of our patrons and donors to enable us to provide high quality community theater to all the residents of the Central Bucks area for many years to come.

In closing, I would like to thank all of our patrons, season ticket holders, Gold Patrons, and donors over the years. Your generosity has enabled us to keep the lights on, improve our infrastructure, and weather hard times.
