For those who do not know me well, outside my time spent at T&C, I am a both a doctor and a research scientist. And from March to June, I worked on medical teams treating COVID-19 patients, before transitioning to a research role. During that time, I felt overwhelmed, terrified, anxious and generally powerless, despite being one of the few people able to actively help those with this disease. And in reflecting on that experience. I thought how much worse this must be for the children in our lives—if adults are actively panicking, confused, and divided, how much harder must it be to be a kid, adapting to circumstances beyond anyone's control and adjusting to seemingly relentless change and disappointment? For many theater kids, myself included, theater was and is a place to grow and develop as a person by getting into the mindset of someone different, to escape from life's problems and to express yourself, to release emotions and let yourself shine. And thus, came the idea for this show—a platform for our young people to act, sing, dance and ultimately both work through the feelings many of us have had about this past year and show how a theater community can come together as a family to support one another and keep the arts alive.

The next step was to figure out a format that would work and make sense on zoom. And in this, inspiration came, fittingly, from childhood. I would be remiss if I did not thank my parents, especially my dad, for insisting we grow up watching old *Walt Disney Presents* specials, including, "From All of Us to All of You," in which Jiminy Cricket and Mickey Mouse serve as our hosts to take us through a series of holiday stories and songs, some of which were classic favorites from Disney animated movies, and some of which were new features, presented as "Christmas cards" to the viewing audience. And I figured if Walt could do it for late 1950's TV, I could do it for 2020 zoom. Here's hoping we did Uncle Walt proud.

This show was written as a collaborative effort, because I knew from the beginning that this work needed and deserved input and feedback from various minds to stay true to its purpose and achieve its goals. So, I called in the team.

First was Mindy Rubinlicht-Torban, who in addition to being an amazing music director, is also quite a wordsmith with parody writing, and an overall miracle worker in terms of getting the videos and songs ready for this show. Next was Melissa Mongi-Copestake, who as director of the youth workshops was already so primed and ready to work with these kids, who also understands my writing style and can perfect my script editing and who is overall, a tremendous joy to work with as a director (as I had learned two years ago). In addition, when this pandemic began, I was in the midst of producing my first actual show, Young Frankenstein, and absolutely loving working with Jessica Briggs, who came on board as our second director as well as our biggest encourager throughout. And finally, we completed our production team with Colby Langweiler, who is not only an amazing ideas person but also a gifted choreographer (as you will see). We brainstormed the song list together and wrote many of the parody songs by bouncing ideas off each other in advance of my writing the script, and so let the betting begin on who contributed what to the songwriting (I'd love to hear your predictions).

A huge thank you and congratulations to them as well as our cast on creating something unique, compelling, emotional and ultimately transcendent. Thanks as well to our fellow Holiday Helpers—Jenny McNiven, Julie Coulton-Massa, Heidi New, Scott Monsees, and Suzanne Ardite for making this 2020 holiday season at T&C merry and bright.

And so, from all of us, to all of you, we're glad to have you with us, now here we go and here's our show that sends a Merry Christmas (and Happy Holidays)!
