Deathtrap was written by Ira Levin who is a prolific author, playwright and screenwriter. He has an amazing talent for creating great stories with well-developed characters, solid story lines and juicy plot twists. His books include A Kiss Before Dying, Rosemary's Baby, The Stepford Wives, The Boys from Brazil and Sliver. All of these books were made into major motion pictures. He also wrote the book and lyrics for the musical Drat! The Cat. The musical includes the iconic Barbara Streisand song He Touched Me.

**Deathtrap** still holds the record for longest-running comedy thriller on Broadway. **Deathtrap** the movie starred Michael Caine (what movie wasn't this man in), Christopher Reeve (his first movie role after Superman) and Dyan Cannon (nominated for 3 Academy Awards and was married to Cary Grant).

Levin has won numerous awards including: The Bram Stoker Award, was nominated for a Tony Award for *Deathtrap*, and also won the Edgar Allan Poe Award. Levin received Lifetime Achievement Awards from both the Mystery Writers of America and Horror Writers United.

STAGE MANAGER


