DIRECTOR'S NOTE

If John Cleese, Terry Gilliam, Eric Idle, Terry Jones, Michael Palin, and the late Graham Chapman hadn't found each other in the late 1960s and created the Monty Python troupe, well, let's not even imagine what we might have lost. No "Philosopher's Song," no cheese shop sketch, nobody expecting the Spanish Inquisition, and certainly no *Monty Python and the Holy Grail*, the brilliant, absurdist, wickedly funny movie that forms the basis for *Spamalot*.

I readily admit that I'm a *Holy Grail* nerd. I've seen the movie dozens of times, and I still crack up in the scene where Herbert's father can't get his son's guards to understand their strikingly simple task. I might not know the airspeed velocity of an unladen swallow, but I know a One For The Ages comedy when I see it.

Spamalot might use Holy Grail for its skeleton, but it also borrows from other Python sketches, including the Spam® Sketch ("Well, there's Spam®, egg, sausage, and spam, that's not got much Spam® in it"), Finland (the country where I quite want to be), and the Dead Parrot Sketch ("He's probably pining for the fjords"), among others. But the show also stands completely on its own, thanks to the cleverness and ingenuity of Idle and his music collaborator, John Du Prez. You needn't have ever seen the movie to fully enjoy the musical.

Bringing this classic to you is a staggeringly talented group of performers, each of whom brings their own energy and artistry to their roles. With everyone at least doubling up on roles, and many of them tripling and more, the backstage chaos of costume changes and searches for that danged prop always seems to lead to pure joy on stage, not just for you but for us too.

On behalf of this extraordinary cast and this marvelous crew, please do fully enjoy the show — and perhaps have a bit of Spam® as well!

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

SPECIAL DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Spamalot contains a musical number called "You Won't Succeed on Broadway," which some might find offensive. Please know that the authors wrote the number as an "homage to all of the great Jewish composers, lyricists, and producers who helped to create Broadway."

Although the authors offered an alternative version of the number, I am proud to present the authors' original version here, on the Town & Country Players stage.

It is our own passionate homage to such Broadway icons as Irving Berlin, Stephen Sondheim, George Gershwin, Lorenz Hart, Alan Menken, Jule Styne, Aaron Copland, Arthur Laurents, Marvin Hamlisch, Mel Brooks, Richard Rodgers, and—of course—Doylestown's beloved Oscar Hammerstein II.

T&C WANTS YOU TO KNOW.....

Welcome to the Town and Country Players' 2023 Season. This season is our 76th season of bringing quality community theater to the Bucks County Area.

Last year, we celebrated our 75th Anniversary Season with a full schedule, including five mainstage productions, a One Act Festival, a 24-Hour Play Festival, a ballet, and a Holiday Show. This year, we once again have a full calendar of events, with five mainstage shows, the return of our One Act Festival and Holiday Show, another 24-Hour Play Festival, and a new-to-T&C Youth Musical this summer. In addition, we are continuing to offer our Youth Workshops this summer, and other workshops on all aspects of theater throughout the year.

But none of our productions would be possible without the having a location to perform in. This winter, we accomplished major upgrades in our space to both improve the patron experience and the quality of the product presented on stage.

The major upgrade this winter was a \$20,000 improvement to our front parking lot. As you may be aware, due to environmental concerns and the need to control storm water runoff, our parking areas are not paved, but grass covered. In general, this works well, but in times of heavy rain, can cause issues. To address this, we installed environmentally friendly permeable pavers to stabilize the handicap and front parking areas and improve the experience for our patrons. We were also able to significantly upgrade our electrical system in support of our stage lighting needs.

Of course, we never want to stop improving our unique facility. Our next planned capital improvement project is the installation of an ADA compliant handicap ramp to allow easier access to our facility for all. To get this ramp built, we will continue to rely upon the support of our patrons and donors to enable us to provide high quality community theater to all the residents of the Central Bucks area for many years to come.

In closing, I would like to thank all of our patrons, season ticket holders, Gold Patrons, and donors over the years. Your generosity has enabled us to keep the lights on, improve our infrastructure, and weather hard times.
